

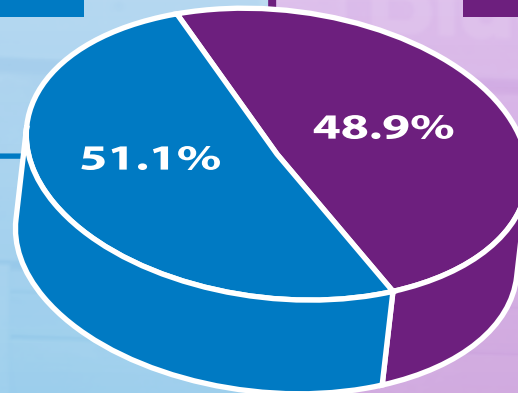


INPATIENT VS. OUTPATIENT SURGERIES IN U.S. HOSPITALS

Outpatient surgeries are on the rise. Nearly half of the 19 million surgeries performed in community hospitals in 28 States were outpatient surgeries.

Total **inpatient surgeries** in 2012: 9.7 million. Percentages below show body systems most commonly addressed in inpatient surgery.

Total **outpatient surgeries** in 2012: 9.3 million. Percentages below show body systems most commonly addressed in outpatient surgery.

Respiratory Surgeries: 86.9%

Cardiovascular Surgeries: 71.7%

Obstetric Surgeries: 97.7%

Eye Surgeries: 98.8%

Ear Surgeries: 91.8%

Nose, Mouth & Throat Surgeries: 86.7%
